The PA UB-GSA APU Linkage Master Program is a collaborative academic program between Post Graduate Program in Public Administration, Faculty of Administrative Science, the University of Brawijaya (PA UB) and Graduate School of Asia Pacific Studies, Ritsumeikan Asia Pacific University (GSA APU).



The PA UB - GSA APU Linkage Master's Program is designed to strengthen the skill and knowledge of students in public administration and international cooperation policy. The program is taught entirely in English.

Features:

Tailor-made curriculum
First year at the University of Brawijaya, Indonesia
Second year at Ritsumeikan Asia Pacific University, Japan

Target Group and Career Destinations:

Graduate students from various educational backgrounds want to develop their capabilities and career development in public administration and international cooperation policy. They include talented government officials, lecturers, researchers, NGO activities, fresh graduate students and etc.

Requirement and Admission

- A bachelor's degree or its equivalent with evidence of a good academic record;
- Proficiency in the English language at the level of a TOEFL score of 550, IELTS 6 or above;
- Competency in conducting research and writing in English; and
- Other additional requirements and admissions in each university.



Credits and Transfer of Credit:

The Linkage Master Program (LMP) follows must take at least thirty seven credits at PA UB, including a master's thesis (10 credits) and thirty six credits at GSA APU.

The Linkage Master Program (LMP) may transfer the maximum of:

- ten (10) credits as part of the graduation requirement at PA UB
- twelve (12) credits as part of the graduation requirement at GSA APU

Academic Year:

PA UB's academic year starts in September and the GSA APU academic year starts in September

Degrees:

2 Master's degrees issued by both PA UB and GSA APU. The academic degree awarded by the PA UB is Master of Public Administration (MPA), while the degree awarded by the GSA APU is Master of Science (M.Sc) in International Cooperation Policy.
