The PA UB - GSIR-RU Linkage Master's Program is a collaborative academic program between Post Graduate Program in Public Administration, Faculty of Administrative Science, the University of Brawijaya (PA UB) and Graduate School of International Relations, Ritsumeikan University (GSIR-RU)

The PA UB - GSIR-RU Linkage Master's Program is designed to strengthen the skill and knowledge of students in public administration and international relations. The program is taught entirely in English.

Credits and Transfer of Credit

The Linkage Master Program (LMP) fellows must take at least thirty seven credits at PA UB, including a master's thesis (10 credits) and thirty credits at GSIR-RU

The Linkage Master Program (LMP) may transfer the maximum of

- ten (14) credits as part of the graduation requirement at GSIR-RU and
- twelve (12) credits as part of the graduation requirement at PA UB
